Materials & Tools:

- Polymer clay (white)
- LC Machine, Roller
- LC Stencils set 3
- Mica powders for polymer clay (pearl and green)
- Small brush
- Cookie cutter
- · Scalpel, blade
- Sandpaper
- Mini-drill
- 4 jump rings and earring hooks




Condition polymer clay. Prepare sheet (about 2 mm thick) of polymer clay in white color. Place remove the LC Stencil.

Apply green and pearl mica powders and carefully remove the LC Stencil.


Cut the desired shape using a cookie cutter.

Bake in the oven according to the manufacturer's an LC Stencil on the sheet and gently roll over with an acrylic roller.




If necessary, sand the edges and backside. You Drill a hole for hanging. can also use UV resin to make earring more shiny.






Assemble the earrings using jump rings and earring hooks.
